



STEAMengine at Whittlesea Tech School: Registration Form

STEAMengine makerspace is a place in which young people with shared interests can gather for making, learning, exploring and sharing that uses high tech to no tech tools. The Tech School has a range of equipment, including 3D printers, laser cutters, robotics, sewing machines, garment printers, vinyl cutters etc.

STEAMengine runs every Wednesday at the Whittlesea Tech School, Building N, 415 Dalton Road, Epping during the school term. The makerspace is open between the hours of 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm for students in Year 7 to 12 living in the City of Whittlesea.

STEAMengine program is free of charge. Places are limited and completion of the registration form is required before young people can attend the program.

Attendance

Tech School staff will be in attendance for the duration of the program to supervise attendees and maintain Duty of Care whilst attendees are <u>onsite</u> at the Tech School. Young people are able to attend between the hours of 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm and sign themselves in and out of the program; notifying a staff member if they leave early. Arrangements for your child to return home upon departure are the responsibility of the parent/guardian and young person.
